Budget constraints:
Forms of grant and maximum reimbursement rates: the FP7 'Rules for Participation' propose three potential forms of grant for the European Union financial contribution: reimbursement of eligible costs, flat rate financing including scale of unit costs, and lump sum financing. In this work programme, for all funding schemes, the reimbursement of eligible costs (including the different options for flat rates on indirect costs as established in Article 32 of the Rules

for Participation) will be the only form of grant used. Pursuant to Article 30 of the Rules for Participation, participants from International Cooperation Partner Countries may choose to opt for lump sum financing.

Giving the limited amount of budget available, and the downstream character of the research, requiring a high financial commitment by proposers, the upper limits foreseen in the call FP7- GALILEO – 2011 – ENTR–1 are lower than the upper limits foreseen in the Rules for Participation (Article 33) for the European Union financial contribution, and are summarized in the following table.
